

Dept. of Labor Collects for Villages

Thirty - Four Emmonak, Alaska villagers today are \$8200 richer in back pay collected for them by the Alaska Department of Labor.

The previously unpaid wages were due the villagers

for work during the 1967 fishing season. They had been employed by Yukon Pacific Fisheries, Inc., a Fairbanks firm.

Commissioner of Labor Thomas J. Moore praised the Attorney General's Office for its quick work of assisting in the claims and further said this is but one more result of Governor Hickel's pledge to protect and assist the working man of Alaska.
