

Aleut League Takes Rasmuson To Aleutians

The Aleut League President Flore Lekanof said that the League is sponsoring a trip through the Aleutian area and the Pribilof Island this month.

Elmer Rasmuson, a candidate for U.S. Senate now occupied by Sen. Ernest Gruening, is traveling with the group visiting ten communities on Aleutian Peninsula, the Aleutian chain and

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St. Paul Island.

Rasmuson is a Republican and Gruening is a Democrat.

Flore Lekanof, Rep. Carl Moses, secretary-treasurer of the League, and Roger Connor, attorney for the group, are representing the Aleut League.

They are being accompanied by two consultants Dr. Herschel F. Jones of Seattle and attorney Donald H. Green

of the firm of Wald, Harkrader & Rockefeller of Washington, D. C.

Elmer Rasmuson is a member of the Aleut League.

"This trip will afford Mr. Rasmuson an opportunity to survey the needs of the Aleut country at close range and to meet its very fine people," said Flore Lekanof.

The traveling group's itinerary was listed as

follows:

May 22, St. Paul; May 23, Cold Bay; May 23, Sand Point and King Cove; back to Cold Bay on May 24 and then to Nikolski; May 25, Unalaska; May 26, Akutan, False Pass, Paul of Harbor and back to Cold Bay; May 27, Belkofski; and May 28, Anchorage.
