Memorial for D. Jenness Anthropologica

Saint Paul University in Ottawa, Canada plans to honor the memory of Dr. Diamond Jenness in a special issue of the school's journal and needs the help of Alaskans to do so.

Dr. Jenness landed very near Prudhoe Bay while with the Canadian Arctic Expedition of 1913-1916.

While in Canada, he was adopted by an Eskimo family.

"To the end of his days," a university spokesman wrote, "he wondered and worried about the future of the native peoples of the North."

Known as the Canadian Research Centre for Anthropology, the university would like to hear from anyone in Alaska who met or knew Dr. Jenness.

"We would like reminiscences and tributes to this man," the spokesman said, "who put his humanity before his research and served both well."
