

Energy Options '86, March 20-23

Several presentations of interest to rural Alaskans will be offered at Energy Options '86, the Seventh Annual Alaska Energy Conference. The conference will take place March 20-23 at the Hotel Captain Cook in Anchorage, and will include seminars, workshops and tours on home energy conservation, independent energy generations, and energy-efficient construction.

Included in the Saturday, March 21 General Conference are several programs related to rural energy. Glenn Collver will speak on RurAL CAP's low-cost home weatherization program. Phil Kaluza of Kaweruk, Inc., in Nome, will talk about the benefits of replacing kerosene pot burners with the Monitor 20 heater. Jeff Wetzlin, of Tanana Chiefs Conference will describe their award-winning passive freezer for villages. Other presentations will cover lending programs, wood stoves, and indoor air quality in superinsulated homes.
