

Anthropologists Complete Work

FAIRBANKS — Alaska anthropologist Arthur E. Hippler and his assistant, John R. Wood, have completed an annotated bibliography of subarctic Athabaskan Indians, in which they have evaluated research on Northern Athabascans of Canada and Alaska.

Designed as a research tool in Athabaskan studies, this reference work is the first in a series of annotated bibliographies to be published by the Institute of Social, Economic and Government Research at the University of Alaska.

Future bibliographies in this field will compile sources on Aleut, Eskimo, and Southeast Alaska Tlingit and Haida groups.
