Traffic accidents can be caused by youngsters throwing snowballs. Alaska State Troopers advised that children throwing snowballs at passing vehicles or school buses will be cited into juvenile court.

son can be charged with assault and battery for hitting another with a snowball.

Last year a snowball was thrown through the open win-

dow of a bus severely injuring the eye of a driver, and almost causing an accident which could have been fatal to a number of students.

Parents are asked to cooperate in emphasizing the dangers of such acts to their children.
