

# Pike to conduct bead workshop

Tlingit artisan Mabel Pike will conduct a five-week bead workshop at the Anchorage Museum of History and Art, beginning Saturday, from 10 a.m. to noon, and continuing March 10, 17, 24 and 30.

The class is open to any interested beginning beaders. Pike will teach the basics of beading, using a two-needle method. Students are welcome to bring their own designs and patterns.

An Anchorage resident since 1968, Pike has taught classes for the Alaska Native Arts and Crafts Cooperative and the Anchorage School District. She learned the art of beading from her family elders in Douglas and enjoys sharing her traditional art form with all who are interested.

The workshop cost is \$50 for museum association members and \$60 for non-members. Participants are responsible for furnishing their own supplies.
