The project will involve wetlands and floodplain impacts, and will be in conformance with Executive Order 11988: Floodplain Management.

If requested, a public hearing would afford interested individuals and organizations an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the preliminary project plans and to express their views and opinions on the features of these plans.
