

Contemporary Native Alaskan crafts collected over the past several years by the Alaska Native Medical Center's Craft Shop will be on display in the second floor Mary Louise Rasmuson Atrium cases of the Anchorage Museum of History and Art through April 28.

The collection, known as the Heritage Collection, is rich in fine examples of current Native craft work, including baskets, skin sewing and beading, ivory and wood carving. It forms the foundation for a permanent exhibit in the new Alaska Native Medical Center.
