

Caribou hearings scheduled

A public meeting to discuss a draft treaty between the U. S. and Canada on caribou will be held in Fairbanks on September 14. Sponsored by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, the meeting will begin at 10 AM at the Fairbanks North Star Borough Library conference room.

The original draft of the treaty was revised at an international meeting in Whitehorse in the spring and completed on May 14, 1979.
