Mrs. Guinn Reconsiders

Mrs. Nora Guinn, Deputy Magistrate in the City of Bethel, has asked the president of the Legal Services Program, Ted Pease, to reconsider her resignation from the Legal Services Board of Directors.

Mrs. Guinn resigned last December when a flare-up occurred in Anchorage when the Board was seeking a director for the Legal Services. She was one of four Board members to resign. All of them were Native members.

In asking for reconsideration, Nora Guinn wrote the following letter:

"I have reconsidered my de-

cision on resignation and I would like to be accepted back on the Legal Service Board. I find that I am unwilling to be part of a group that may eventually stop completely any progress that has been made toward getting legal services to the poor and especially to my own people.

"Every day that passes I find more and more need for this service out in our area. I am more than willing to do my share.

"I sincerely hope that every other native that was originally on the board will reconsider, as I feel they are an especially fine group."
