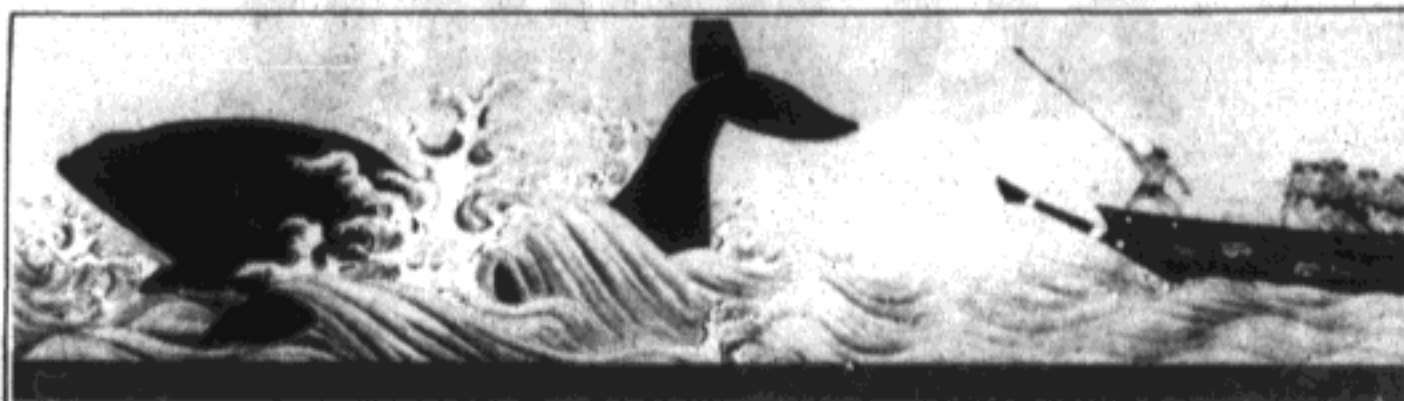


Whalers across the Pacific thank Inupiat captain from Barrow
