

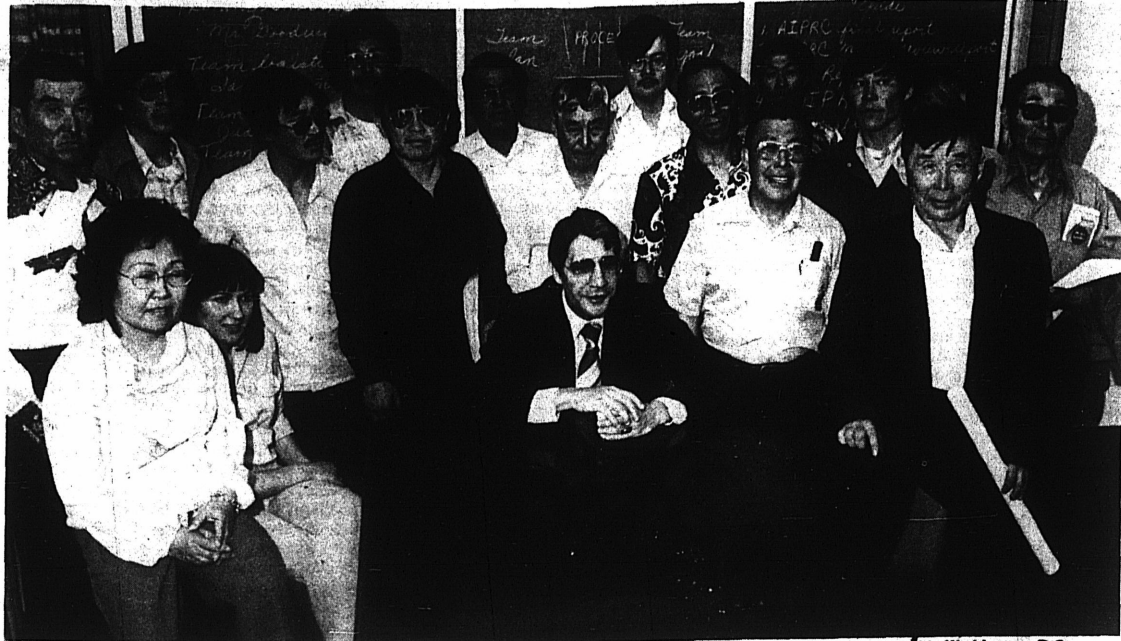
# Catering venture for Doyon

Doyon, Ltd. has announced that it will joint-venture with a Jackson, Mississippi firm to provide industrial catering, and related support services, throughout Alaska and elsewhere. The report appeared in the Alaska Journal of Commerce and Pacific Rim Reporter on May 22.

The new enterprise will begin with pipeline and drilling camp catering, and plans to expand into construction, logging, mining, and government project support services.

Southeastern Services, Inc. is a food service contractor with experience at U.S. military installations.

Doyon, the regional profit corporation for Alaska's interior Indians, is also involved in mineral exploration and owns I-Tech, Ltd., an engineering and surveying company among other holdings.
