

AS 14.43, proposes to amend regulations in Title 20 of the Alaska Administrative Code, relating to the Scholarship Loan Program, as follows:

200 AAC 15.030(g) is amended to correct an error in citation of regulation numbers.

20 AAC 15.030(f), (i) and (k) are amended to clarify repayment provisions and eligibility requirements of the loan program.

20 AAC 15.040 is also amended by adding a new subsection which requires that previous loan recipients whose loans are in repayment be current in payments in order to receive a new loan.

20 AAC 15.055 is amended by adding new subsections which clarify the deferment provisions of the loan program.

20 AAC 15.060 is amended to clarify forgiveness provisions of the loan program. Borrowers in default are not eligible for forgiveness.

20 AAC 15.085 is amended by adding new subsections. The following terms are defined: "maintain a loan," "present" or "physically present," "at least 50 percent disabled" and "successfully complete."

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.
