A grant to implement a general emergency care program has been granted to the Continuing Education in the Health Sciences Department at the University of Alaska, Anchorage.

The Department of Health, Education and Welfare, Region X funded the program which will be presented throughout Alaska now until 1979. Some of the cities to receive the course instruction are Barrow, Kotzebue, Kodiak and Sitka.

The purpose of the program is to provide intensive emergency nursing care skills to all nurses in Alaska with a focus on

the rural/bush areas.
