Sealaska buys UBA stock

Sealaska Corporation, the largest corporation organized pursuant to the 1971 Native Claims Settlement Act, is the most recent corporation to acquire stock in United Bank Alaska.

United Bank Alaska was for-

med four years ago by five regional corporations. In addition to Sealaska, two other regional corporations, Ahtna and Chugach, purchased stock after incorporation. One regional corporation sold its stock

to make other investments, leaving the current ownership with 7 regions, NANA: Bristol Bay Native Corporation; Doyon, Limited; Cook Inlet Region, Inc.; Chugach Natives, Inc.; Ahtna, Incorporated; and Sealaska
