HIGHWAY PROJECT F-M-0575(1)
BONIFACE PARKWAY
TUDOR ROAD TO DEBARR ROAD

Pursuant to Presidential Executive Order 11990, Protection of Wetlands, the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities provides notice of proposal to place fill in wetlands within and adjacent to the South Branch of the South Fork of Cester Creek. Placement of clean granular fill material or poured concrete in these wetlands is necessary for the upgrading of Boniface Parkway from a 24 foot to a 77 foot roadway. The final volume of fill has not yet been determined. The area involved is less than 100 lineal feet of wetlands on each side of the creek.

Placement of fill should not alter local drainage. Comments and requests for specific information concerning wetlands involvement must be received no later than July 6, 1981 at the following address.
