

University offers book on reindeer

"Eskimos, Reindeer and Land" is a newly released book studying the history, sociology and economic of the reindeer industry in Alaska. Written by four University Alaska-Fairbanks faculty, the book was published by the school's Agricultural Experiment Station and the School of Agriculture and Land Resources Management.

The 200-page book includes more than 40 tables and charts. Photos illustrate the industry.

The final chapter studies the Alaska lands issues and various policy considerations for the industry today.

The book, while detailed, is not overly technical. The material is presented so that the average reader can understand it.
