



HERE'S THE EVIDENCE

- Appropriates \$1 million to the Alaska Native Housing Program to match \$10 million in Federal funds of which Congress has only appropriated \$1 million. \$95,000 was appropriated to the Alaska Native Program for immediate implementation of the program. (Chapter 212)
- Authorizes State grants to be made for the construction of basic facilities in rural area communities. (Chapter 201)
- If a district has less than 600 pupirs and maintains both an elementary and a secondary school, it is entitled to one teacher unit (state funded) as an allowance for administrators. (Chapter 48)
