Egan Invites Seaborg, But---

Gov. William A. Egan said last week that Dr. Glenn Seaborg, retiring as chairman of the Atomic Energy Commission, had not vet answered an invitation to visit ground zero at Amchitka when the AEC blows off a bomb there this fall.

Egan, in response to a nationally televised claim by Seaborg that Cannikin, largest underground nuclear test ever, is "completely safe" invited the AEC chief to visit Amchitka with his

family at shot time. "I got word today that Dr. Seaborg is out of the country for three weeks and hasn't been able to respond," Egan said.
