'Live-in' Workshop

The Southeastern Regional Center, University of Alaska, in cooperation with the Departiment of Education, Division of Instructional Services, is offering a course entitled "Individual and Group Techniques in Drug Abuse Education," August 22-28, 1971.

This is a "live-in" workshop being held at the Methodist Church camp in Juneau.

Dr. Mike Giammatteo from the Northwest Regional Educational Laboratory is conducting the workshop on communications, life-style, cross-cultural communications, and effective program set-up.

Participants will be spending 6-7 hours per day on development of skills used by treatment personnel who deal with drug abuse problems.

The course carries two semester hours of University credit and is limited to 30 participants.
