

CINA receives grant

The Cook Inlet Native Association is the recipient of a \$219,973 grant from the Department of Education, the Alaska Congressional Delegation announced today.

The grant will fund a voca-

tional training program for unemployed Alaska Natives. The program, which will be conducted in Anchorage, will provide job skills training that will enable students to work in rural villages. Training will include such subjects as micro-comput-

ers, finance, tourism and clerical skills.

This is the first time Cook Inlet Native Association has received a Department of Education grant for this purpose. The funds will be administered over a 36-month period.
