CINA receives grant

The Cook Inlet Native Association is the recipient of a \$219,973 grant from the Department of Education, the Alaska Congressional Delegation announced today.

The grant will fund a voca-

tional training program for unemployed Alaska Natives. The program, which will be conduc-

ted in Anchorage, will provide job skills training that will enable students to work in rural villages. Training will include such subjects as micro-computers, finance, tourism and clerical skills.

This is the first time Cook Inlet Native Association has received a Department of Education grant for this purpose. The funds will be administered over a 36-month period.
