

Ketchikan artshow set

The 19th annual Ketchikan Arts and Crafts Show will be held May 4 through May 6 at Ketchikan's National Guard Armory.

Co-chairman Mrs. Kathy Laub said that the exhibit is open to anyone who wishes to enter, but that only original works would be accepted.

The eight exhibit categories include: watercolor paintings, oil and acrylic painting, fibre arts— (weaving, macrame, batik, creative stitchery, needle-point); earth arts (works in

stone, wood, clay, metal, glass, wax, ivory, bone, leather); graphics (drawings in any media, prints); photography (minimum 8x10 required); Native arts, tole and decorative arts.

The deadline for receipt of out-of-town entries is May 1, 1984.
