

Fairbanks Awarded \$297,000

JUNEAU—The City of Fairbanks has been awarded a \$297,000 Federal grant to help build a water line to an industrial area, the Office of Governor Keith H. Miller announced last week.

The funds from the Economic Development Administration were made available under the Public Works and Economic De-

velopment Act of 1965, Governor Miller said.

The City will match the grant to complete the \$594,000 total cost of the project.

The water line will be extended to serve an area owned by the Alaska Railroad Company and is designed to help stimulate industrial and commercial growth, Governor Miller said.
