

Senator Bartlett Out of Hospital; Rests at Home

Sen. E. L. (Bob) Bartlett of Alaska was released from Georgetown University Hospital in the nation's capitol yesterday to his home where he will rest for an undetermined period of time.

Sen. Bartlett entered the hospital three weeks ago after suffering chest pains and irregular heart beat.

The ailment was later diagnosed as the inflammation of the heart lining.

It is reported that the Senator is recuperating satisfactorily and that examinations revealed that he had not suffered a heart attack and there was no damage to his heart.
