BUILDERS/BUILDING OWNERS ENGINEERS/ARCHITECTS

Before Construction Begins on any occupancy or building, plans and specifications regarding location on property, area, height, number of stories, type of construction, interior finish, exit facilities, electrical systems, mechanical systems, automatic fire extinguishing and fire alarm systems must be submitted to the **FAIRBANKS REGIONAL OFFICE of the ALASKA STATE FIRE MARSHAL.**

NOTE: exception: The above does not pertain to single family dwellings, duplexes or tri-plexes.

NOTE: FOR ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS, CONTACT YOUR LOCAL JURISDICTION FOR INFORMATION REGARDING SPECIAL CODES AND ORDINANCES.

Failure to submit plans as required per 13AAC 50.027 can result in costly construction delays, possible building construction changes or legal action pursuant to applicable statutes and laws currently in effect.

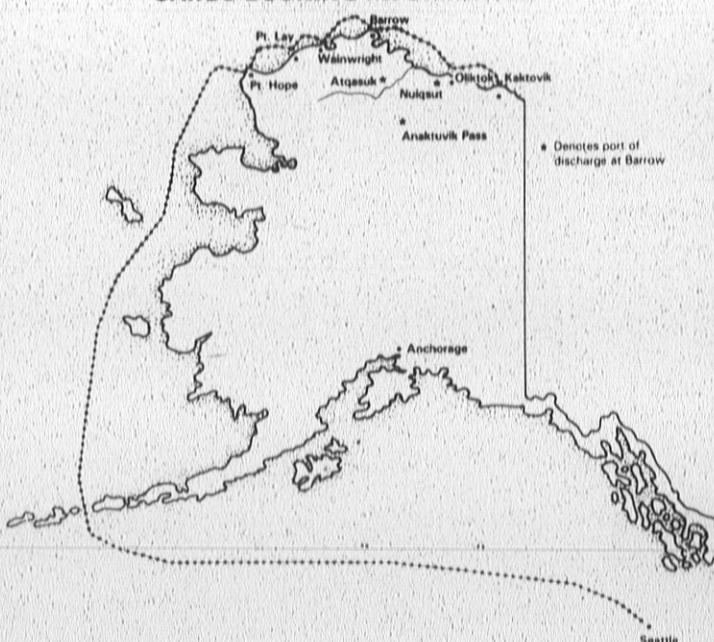

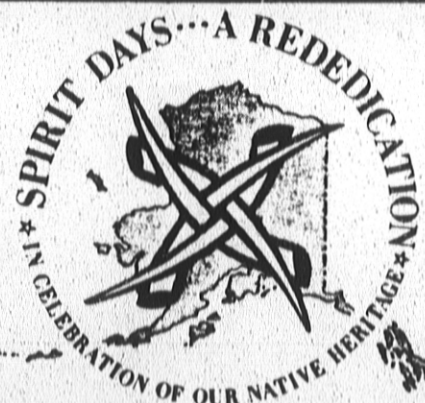
