

Largest publisher is federal government

On July 14th, the Library of the University of Alaska will host a seminar on the publication programs of the United States government. The federal government is the world's largest publisher, supplying information on topics as varied as cabin construction, consumer

protection, U.S. history, environmental impact statements, cooking "recipes" and vital statistics.

Seminar participants will describe how these documents are available through the federal depository system, which publications can be found in

Fairbanks, and how to go about locating information in federal documents. The U of A is a depository for many federal publications, and provides local citizens with access to the documents.

The seminar is open to anyone interested at no charge. They meet from 9 a.m. to noon, Thursday, July 14th in room 102 of the University library.
