Mable Sampson, daughter of Rex and Josephine graduated from Kotzebue Day School last spring. She was on her way to Sheldon Jackson for her freshman year.

She is survived by an elder brother, Clarence, now in Vietnam; her sisters Wynona, Caroline and Eva.

Alvin Morris of Noorvik, a spring graduate of Beltz School in Nome, also died on his way to Sheldon Jackson. His parents are Minnie and Walter, who run a small store in Noorvik.

Minnie Lane of Point Hope was the daughter of Amos and Eunice Lane. She, like the others was also headed for Sheldon Jackson College.
