

# Can Get Bill by Mail

Printed copies of the latest Alaska Native land claims bill, S. 3586, has been received in Alaska and are available at the office of Senator Ernest Gruening, 227 Federal Building, Anchorage.

The bill, which was proposed by Secretary of the Interior Stewart L. Udall,

was introduced in the Senate June 4 by Senator Henry M. Jackson, chairman of the Interior and Insular Affairs Committee, by request.

Three earlier bills designed to settle the land claims problem were introduced by Senator Gruening.

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
