

Dancing to highlight Huslia mushers' carnival

A dance every night with violin music and a local rock'n roll band is scheduled to be held at Huslia during the Huslia Junior Dog Mushers Carnival April 3 through 5 and the Koyukuk River Championship Dog Race scheduled April 9 through 12.

A \$10,000 purse is set for cash prizes in the first annual Koyukuk River Championship races with first place day money set at \$250, \$350 for the second and \$400 for the third day of the race scheduled to begin on Thursday.

The mushers drawing will be held on April 8. Entry

fee is set at \$100.00. A raffle will be held for a grand prize of a 340 Galaxy Snow Machine, second prize of \$200 and a third prize of \$100.

Other events scheduled during the Koyukuk Championships include a women's sled dog race, lead dog contest, money scramble, a men's and old men's snowshoe races, passenger race, tea making race, sleeping bag race and snowshoe baseball.

The Huslia Junior Dog Mushers Carnival set for April 3 - 5 will include a seven dog race for youngsters.
