Ft. Yukon Community Facility to Be Built

Tom Tull, project director of the City of Fort Yukon announced today that contracts have been signed with Fairbanks Builders, Inc. for the construction of the Fort Yukon community facility.

The cost of the construction will be \$449,842. The building was designed by Alaska Architectural and Engineering Co. of Fairbanks.

The project is funded in part by a grant from the federal Department of Housing and Urban Development and is the first such project to be funded in Alaska under the Neighborhood Facili-

ties Program.

The rest of the funding is coming from the Protestant Episcopal Church through the Missionary District of Alaska and from the State Department of Education.

The building will be made available to the state school for physical education classes and other events. It is going to be built on ground right next to the state school donated by the Student Council for that purpose.

The building will house a gymnasium, public showers, laundromat and multipurpose education rooms for use by such programs as Head Start and Adult Basic Education.
