

Playwrights! You have until Feb. 1 to submit your work

Perseverence Theatre of Juneau has issued a reminder that the deadline for submission of plays to the Great Alaskan Playrush is Feb. 1, 1988.

The playrush is an annual statewide playwriting competition conducted by Perseverence Theatre and sponsored by Chevron U.S.A.

This year there are three categories for entries, one for adults ages 19 and up, one for young adults grades 7-12, and a category for elementary school pupils grades 1-6.

There are cash prizes in each category ranging from \$500 to \$25. The first, second and third place entries in each category will be publish-

ed by Perseverence Theatre.

To be eligible, a playwright must be an Alaskan resident and previously produced plays are ineligible. Two copies must be submitted.

The first page of the play must include the title of the play. However, in order that the judges may read the plays without knowledge of the writer's identity, all identifying information about the playwright must appear on a detachable title page.

The title page must contain the playwright's name, mailing address, phone number, grade, and title of the play. Manuscripts will not be returned.
