SJC receives grant

The U.S. Office of Education has announced approval of a \$56,000 grant to Sheldon Jackson College for a cooperative Educational Program.

This is a "earn and learn" program in which students spend part time studying and part time working while obtaining hands on experience.

Certain businesses and industries in the Sitka area have offered to provide work opportunity for students in the program. Other opportunities are needed. Employment beyond the Sitka area is also being sought.

Program areas include business, fishing, forestry, and community services. Supervision by faculty is provided both while the student is in the classroom and on the job.
