Litigation Costs For Hootch Case

Francis M. Flavin, Executive Director of Alaska Legal Services Corporation announced recently that the Field Foundation of New York has awarded the program \$5,000 for litigation costs in Hootch vs. Alaska State-Operated Schools, a class action filed on behalf of Native children living in remote villages of the state.

The suit seeks to provide secondary education to these children in their place of residence. Mr. Flavin stated that this fund will enable Alaska Legal Service to continue its efforts in this case.

The grant is a one-time award

for a period of one year.
