

IT'S NOT REALLY Alaska's version of the "Big Bertha" cannon . . . it's a 60-foot-long section of pipe at a pipe storage yard in Fairbanks. The 48-inch-diameter pipe for the trans-Alaska pipelline is being readled for shipment to points along the 798-mille-long pipelline route. Full-scale pipelline construction is expected to be under way in the early spring of 1975.
