

Wendell Kay Throws In Hat

For State Gubernatorial Race

Anchorage attorney and a former Executive Director of the Alaska State Housing Authority, Wendell P. Kay, formally announced his candidacy for the Governor of Alaska.

He announced his intention last Wednesday in a press conference at his home in Anchorage. He will enter his

name in the Democratic Primary to be held this August.

"I am running for Governor because I truly believe that the position offers a tremendous opportunity to build a great and vital state; a unique challenge to make Alaska the most wholesome, prosperous and happy place to live in the entire United States," Kay declared.

"I have always felt that the Constitution gives us the right not only to pursue happiness, but to actually catch a little of it."

Wendell Kay is the first man to announce his candidacy for governor. Governor William A. Egan, incumbent, former Gov-
