

Wolf Trappers Need Permits

With the close of the regular trapping season for mink, marten and land otter, it is necessary for wolf trappers to obtain a wolf trapping permit from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game.

Trapping season closed January 22 in Game Management Units 1A, 1B, 2, 3, and 4 and January 31 in Units 1C and 5.

Applications for wolf trapping are available from any Fish and Game office, said John Crawford, southeastern regional game supervisor. When applying, the trapper should be sure to include his trapping license number and the exact area he wishes to trap. He added there is no cost for the permit.
