The work includes securing complete medical evaluation to assess the applicant's remaining capabilities, aptitude and psychological testing to assess job potentials, counseling and guidance service, development of training programs, provision of artificial limbs, medical treatment, with views to return persons to gainful employment.

"We feel fortunate in having secured the services of Leonard Hamilton who will be serving the Fairbanks and Interior areas on a full-time basis," said Dale Reeves, State Supervisor for the OVR.
