I HEAR WEIRD TALES OF TRIPS PEOPLE MADE IN ORDER TO GET INTO JUNEAU, DO YOU HAVE ANY EXAMPLES?

Late January-early February of this year, voters trying to reach Juneau were dumped off in Ketchikan, boarded a transit ferry, then a taxi to the Alaska ferry going via Wrangell, Petersburg and Juneau thence a cab to the hotel. Some 300 people were involved, taking 36 hours to get to Juneau from Anchorage.

On return, to get a plane back to Anchorage from Juneau (with approximately 400 people sitting in the Juneau airport), it took some of them 4 days to catch a plane due to bad weather.

They could have driven to Willow and returned home in a matter of hours.
