




NOTICE TO THE VOTERS OF ATQASUK

An election will be held in Atqasuk on October 5, 1982 to determine whether:

- 1) the voters desire incorporation of a second class city;
- 2) the voters authorize the levy of a two percent (2%) sales tax, the incorporation of Atqasuk is conditioned upon the authorization of the sales tax proposition;
- 3) if incorporation is approved, the election of the initial seven person council.

Any person who is a qualified voter in Alaska and is a resident of the area of the proposed city for 30 days is qualified to vote in the election.

The polling place in Atqasuk is the School Building. The polls will be open from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF GRANTS

FOR CHILD CARE TRAINING/EDUCATION

The Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs has grant funds available to qualified organizations desiring to provide training and/or education to child care employees and administrators. The total amount of grant funds available is \$50,000. Grant applications may be based on the provision of training and/or education at the community, regional or state level.

To be considered for funding, a grant application must be postmarked to the Department no later than September 27, 1982. All grants will be reviewed and awarded on a competitive basis.
