

Hammond announces approval

Governor Jay Hammond has announced approval of \$1.9 million for construction of a 42-unit elderly housing project in Juneau.

Hammond said final approval has just been received from the Department of Housing and Urban Development. The Alaska State Housing Authority project will be built on the 12th street site of the Harborview area in Juneau.

Linn Forest of Linn A Forest Architects in Juneau was selected by the ASHA Board of Directors to provide the architectural services for the units.

Bill Miles, executive director of ASHA, said the project will go out to competitive bid by general contractors when drawings and specifications are complete.

Hammond said work on the project is expected to begin in the fall of this year. It is expected to be ready for occupancy in August, 1977.
