

Brisk Traffic Hits at Wien Consolidated

Wien Consolidated Airlines passenger traffic, mail and freight volumes increased considerably during November 1968 over the same month a year ago, A.E. (Bud) Hagberg, vice president, marketing announced today.

Totals show a passenger increase of 60.9 percent; mail volume up by 21.01 percent and freight jumped by 42.33 percent, he said.

With the addition of a second 737 jet in operation in December and more frequent schedules, it is anticipated that volume will continue to rise.

Current schedules provide for three jet flights weekly from Anchorage and Fairbanks to Whitehorse and Juneau on Monday, Wednesday and Friday departing at 9:15 a.m. This permits those who wish to stop over in Juneau to do so and catch a southbound state ferry or connect with Western Airlines there.

To Nome there are six jet flights weekly from Anchorage.

Five additional jet flights weekly between Fairbanks and Anchorage have been added.
