

Ephrata Prefab Houses for Slope

Ephrata, Wash. is reported to be busy making prefabricated houses for the North Slope's growing population of oil workers.

The houses are said to be made into sections so they can easily be transported by Hercules freight planes to the Slope.

The houses have been designed to withstand 50 mile gales and 75 degrees below zero temperatures.

It has been rumored that some 6,000 workers will populate the North Slope by June, 1969.
