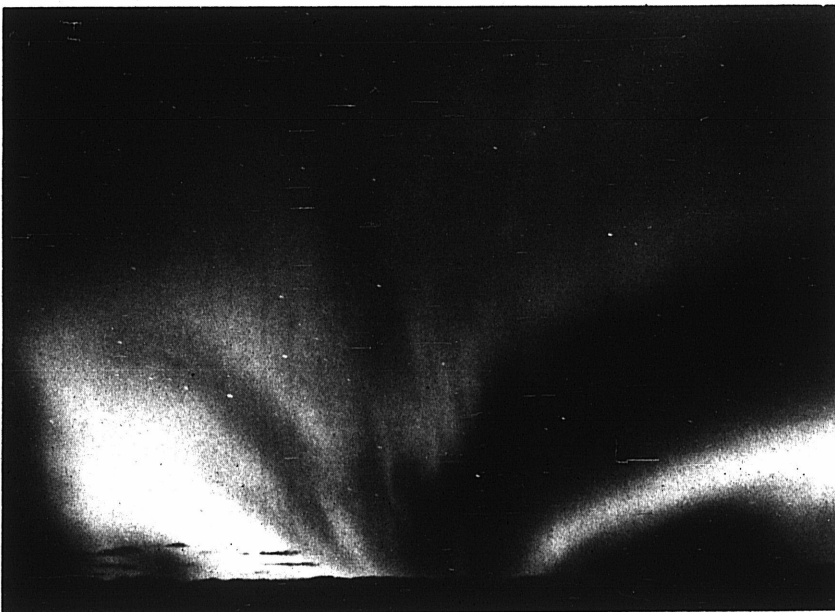

Capturing the Northern Lights

Tundra Times Howard Rock Intern Robert Koweluk captured the Northern Lights over Fairbanks late last month in the photograph above. Our talented photographer took this picture on September 29 between 11:15 P.M. and 12:15 A.M. on the Nenana Highway ten miles south of the University campus. Koweluk provided a little technical information which may be of interest to photographers. The exposures were made at 8 seconds each using Kodak Tri-X 400 A.S.A. film with the camera's aperture setting at f2.
