REGULATIONS OF THE ALASKA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION Notice is given that the ALASKA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION, under uthority vested by AS 42.05.151(a), proposes to adopt regulations in Title of the Alaska Administrative Code to implement and make specific AS 42.5.141, 42.05.151.1, and 42.05.01, as follows:

3 AAC 52 is amended by adding Article 3 (sections 160-310, inclusive) which establishes service standards to ensure that reasonable, continuous, uninterrupted and undelayed telephone service will be rendered to the public. Where appropriate, the standards define service levels that generally indicate the point at which there is need for corrective action to be taken by the utility.

The proposed regulations would require that telephone utilities adhere to standards and practices in the following areas, including but not limited
