Movie of Tununak Eskimos

"Tununereumiut," a new film about the contemporary lives of Tununak Island Eskimos will be shown on "Bailiwick" today. The producer, director and cinematographer of the film will be interviewed following the showing.

Lenny Kamerling, who made the film in cooperation with Tununak Island residents, will be interviewed by host Tom Duncan, Executive Producer for KUAC FM and TV.

Reg Emmert, Cinemato-

grapher for the University of Alaska's Division of Media Services will also be on the program.

Kamerling will tell how the film was made, and talk with Emmert about film-making in Alaska.

One unusual aspect of Kamerling's film is that he uses "real time" to show the events of the film, as opposed to the often artificial shortening of time seen in movies.

Bailiwick is a locally produced program usually seen at 7:30 p.m. Wednesdays on KUAC-TV, channel 9 in the Fairbanks area. This special program will pre-empt "World We Live In" normally seen at that time.
