

Cowper appoints Barrow man to 5-person boundary panel

JUNEAU — Gov. Steve Cowper has announced appointments to several state boards and commissions including Ben Nageak of Barrow to the five-member Local Boundary Commission.

Nageak was appointed from the 2nd Judicial District for a term expiring January 1988.
