

APA awards contract for Klawock work

The Alaska Power Authority has awarded an \$811,000 design-build contract to Humphrey Co. of Anchorage for construction of the Craig-Klawock Intertie.

The six-mile intertie will allow Alaska Power and Telephone, which serves Craig, to sell economy power to the Tlingit-Haida Regional Electric Authority, which serves Klawock.

Surveying for the project, which is currently underway, is being conducted by Kaiser-Filucci. Right-of-way clearing for the project will be performed by Bradley Construction/Timber Fellers.

The contract calls for the work to be finished by the end of November.
