Tongass plan to be revised

JUNEAU — The Tongass Land Mangement Plan is the first forest plan in the nation to undergo a major revision. Michael A. Barton, regional forester, has assigned a team of resource specialists to develop the revised Forest Plan by the end of 1989.

Barton said the Forest Service is taking a second look at management of the Tongass National Forest as a result of changes in public values, needs and knowledge about forest management activities and resources.

The Tongass Land Management Plan was the first National Forest plan developed following the National Forest Managment Act of 1976.
